

MARIE-PIERRE GAGNON, PhD

She completed her Ph. D. in 2003 on telemedicine adoption by physicians, followed by a post-doctorate in Health Technology Assessment in Barcelona, and a post-doctorate in Health Telematics at the University of Calgary. She is currently an Associate Professor in the Faculty of nursing at Laval University and a regular researcher at the Quebec University Hospital Centre. She holds the Tier 2 Canada Research Chair in Technologies and Practices in Health.

Her research program focuses on the use of scientific evidence to support the implementation of innovations in the health care system. She is particularly interested in knowledge translation, patient and public involvement in health care decisions, and the use of information and communication technologies in the health care system.

She is principal investigator of 21 research grants supported by funding agencies in Canada. She has received research contracts from Canada Health Infoway, WHO and UNICEF. She has also collaborated to research projects in Africa, Latin America and Europe. She has published over 100 scientific articles and collaborated to 23 research reports and 6 books. She currently supervises 11 doctoral and 3 Master's students. She is also involved as a trainer in systematic reviews with the Cochrane Collaboration.

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
